# THE TOWN OF BURLINGTON'S COMMUNITY CHOICE POWER SUPPLY PROGRAM CONSUMER NOTIFICATION



The Town of Burlington is pleased to announce that **Constellation NewEnergy, Inc.** ("Constellation") has been selected as the supplier for its Community Choice Power Supply Program ("Program"). Constellation will provide electric power supply for all consumers currently on Basic Service in Burlington. This notice is intended to tell you about this Program for electric power supply. In accordance with state law, it also informs you of your rights and options if you choose not to participate in the Program.

**YOU WILL NOT NOTICE ANY CHANGE IN YOUR ELECTRICITY SERVICE.** The only difference you will see is that Constellation will be printed under the "Supplier Services" section of your monthly bill. You will continue to receive one bill from Eversource. You will continue to send your payments to Eversource for processing. Eversource will continue to respond to emergencies, read meters and maintain the distribution and transmission lines. Reliability and quality of service will remain the same. Furthermore, you will continue to have all existing consumer rights and protections.

**IF YOU ARE A BASIC SERVICE CONSUMER WHO HAS BEEN MAILED A NOTIFICATION** you do not need to take any action to participate. You will be AUTOMATICALLY enrolled and start benefiting from the aggregation rate beginning on the day of the month in October 2024 that your meter is read. This date varies by service area. Your meter reading date is shown on your bill.

### WATCH YOUR EVERSOURCE BILL FOR FURTHER NOTIFICATION of the Program.

- Your October 2024 bill will state that you are being switched to Burlington's Program.
- Your November 2024 bill will show Burlington's supplier and aggregation rate under "Supplier Services".

BUDGET PLAN OR ELIGIBLE LOW-INCOME RATE CONSUMERS will continue to receive those benefits from Eversource.

**SOLAR PANEL AND COMMUNITY SOLAR CONSUMERS** will continue to receive net metering or on-bill credits while receiving electricity supply under the Program and the value of these credits will not be altered by participating in the Program.

**ANY APPLICABLE TAXES WILL BE BILLED** as part of the Program's power supply charge. You will be responsible for identifying and requesting an exemption from the collection of taxes by providing appropriate documentation.

**TAX EXEMPT SMALL BUSINESS CONSUMERS** <u>must</u> email or fax a copy of their Energy Exemption Certificate directly to Constellation at <a href="mailto:constellation.com">CNETaxForms@constellation.com</a> or (877) 243-4968 (fax) in order to maintain their tax exempt status.

TO CHOOSE A PRODUCT WITH A HIGHER PERCENTAGE OF RENEWABLE ENERGY visit <u>colonialpowergroup.com/burlington</u> or you may call Constellation at (833) 490-0016 and ask to be enrolled in one of the following products:

- <u>Burlington's Optional Renewable 5 Product</u> provides 5% MA Class I Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) above the state's then-current requirement for these renewables [24% in 2024; 27% in 2025; 30% in 2026]. This product is being offered at \$0.13447 per kWh for 24 months (October 2024 to October 2026).
- <u>Burlington's Optional Renewable 25 Product</u> provides 25% MA Class I RECs above the state's then-current requirement for these renewables [24% in 2024; 27% in 2025; 30% in 2026]. This product is being offered at \$0.14322 per kWh for 24 months (October 2024 to October 2026).

**IF YOU DO NOT WISH TO PARTICIPATE** you must OPT-OUT by signing and returning the Opt-Out Reply Card included with the mailed notification **OR** visit <u>colonialpowergroup.com/burlington</u>, click the OPT-OUT button and follow the instructions specified **OR** call Constellation at (833) 490-0016.

**IF YOU WISH TO JOIN THIS PROGRAM** you may OPT-IN at <u>colonialpowergroup.com/burlington</u> **OR** call Constellation at (833) 490-0016 and ask to be enrolled. If you are currently contracted with your own competitive supplier, you should confirm with them that you will not incur any early termination fees or penalties for leaving their supply.
