**THE TOWN OF NORTH BROOKFIELD’S  
COMMUNITY CHOICE POWER SUPPLY PROGRAM  
CONSUMER NOTIFICATION**



The Town of North Brookfield is pleased to announce that **First Point Power** (“First Point”) has been selected as the supplier for its Community Choice Power Supply Program (“Program”). First Point will provide electric power supply for all consumers currently on Basic Service in North Brookfield. This notice is intended to tell you about this Program for electric power supply. In accordance with state law, it also informs you of your rights and options if you choose not to participate in the Program.

**YOU WILL NOT NOTICE ANY CHANGE IN YOUR ELECTRICITY SERVICE.** The only difference you will see is that First Point will be printed under the “Supply Services” section of your monthly bill. You will continue to receive one bill from National Grid. You will continue to send your payments to National Grid for processing. National Grid will continue to respond to emergencies, read meters and maintain the distribution and transmission lines. Reliability and quality of service will remain the same. Furthermore, you will continue to have all existing consumer rights and protections.

**IF YOU ARE A BASIC SERVICE CONSUMER WHO HAS BEEN MAILED A NOTIFICATION** you do not need to take any action to participate. You will be AUTOMATICALLY enrolled and start benefiting from the aggregation rate beginning on the day of the month in October 2024 that your meter is read. This date varies by service area. Your meter reading date is shown on your bill.

**WATCH YOUR NATIONAL GRID BILL FOR FURTHER NOTIFICATION** of the Program.

- Your October 2024 bill will state that you are being switched to North Brookfield’s Program.
- Your November 2024 bill will show North Brookfield’s supplier and aggregation rate under “Supply Services”.

**BUDGET PLAN OR ELIGIBLE LOW-INCOME RATE CONSUMERS** will continue to receive those benefits from National Grid.

**SOLAR PANEL AND COMMUNITY SOLAR CONSUMERS** will continue to receive net metering or on-bill credits while receiving electricity supply under the Program and the value of these credits will not be altered by participating in the Program.

**ANY APPLICABLE TAXES WILL BE BILLED** as part of the Program’s power supply charge. You will be responsible for identifying and requesting an exemption from the collection of taxes by providing appropriate documentation.

**TAX EXEMPT SMALL BUSINESS CONSUMERS** must email or fax a copy of their Energy Exemption Certificate directly to First Point at [enroll@firstpointpower.com](mailto:enroll@firstpointpower.com) or (877) 206-4855 (fax) in order to maintain their tax exempt status.

**TO CHOOSE A PRODUCT WITH A HIGHER PERCENTAGE OF RENEWABLE ENERGY** visit [colonialpowergroup.com/north-brookfield](http://colonialpowergroup.com/north-brookfield) or you may call First Point at (888) 875-1711 and ask to be enrolled in one of the following products:

- **North Brookfield’s Optional National Renewable Product** provides 38% National Wind Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) above the state’s then-current minimum requirement for renewables [62% in 2024]. This product is being offered at \$0.14242 per kWh for 36 months (October 2024 to October 2027).
- **North Brookfield’s Optional Renewable 50 Product** provides 50% MA Class I RECs above the state’s then-current requirement for these renewables [24% in 2024; 27% in 2025; 30% in 2026; 33% in 2026]. This product is being offered at \$0.16061 per kWh for 36 months (October 2024 to October 2027).

**IF YOU DO NOT WISH TO PARTICIPATE** you must OPT-OUT by signing and returning the Opt-Out Reply Card included with the mailed notification **OR** visit [colonialpowergroup.com/north-brookfield](http://colonialpowergroup.com/north-brookfield), click the OPT-OUT button and follow the instructions specified **OR** call First Point at (888) 875-1711.

**IF YOU WISH TO JOIN THIS PROGRAM** you may OPT-IN at [colonialpowergroup.com/north-brookfield](http://colonialpowergroup.com/north-brookfield) **OR** call First Point at (888) 875-1711 and ask to be enrolled. If you are currently contracted with your own competitive supplier, you should confirm with them that you will not incur any early termination fees or penalties for leaving their supply.
